
"In Service to one, in service to all"

- Knights of Columbus Fish Fry Setup on Thursdays starting February 6th through April 10th.

The coffee and punch area needs to be watched and refilled. Some patrons need assistance going through the serving line. Dining room cleanup and resetting tables is always helpful.
