



## **MASON COUNCIL # 9182 KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Knights of Columbus Council 9182 is sponsoring its yearly scholarship program for all graduating high school seniors, pursuing further education in an academic or technical field at an accredited institution, who are members of The Catholic Community of Sts. James, Cornelius & Cyprian. Scholarships are awarded based on the following criteria:

- Character (who are you)
- Service (what do you do to make others' lives better)
- Leadership (how do you work with others, supporting and/or leading)
- Academics (how have you challenged yourself in your education)

Applicants need to submit a short essay of no less than 200 and no more than 500 words about yourselves including your interests and church activities\*, extracurricular activities, community or service club activities, what you like to do for fun, awards, leadership efforts, and how your chosen field of study will help achieve your life goals.

\*Church Activities may include Altar Servers, ROCK, Encounter, helping with events

Applicants will complete the application form and provide the following:

- Your essay of yourself no less than 200 and no more 500 words.
- Two reference letters discussing your activities in the church and/or community, how you relate with others, extracurricular activities. Consider for letters church leaders, teachers, coaches, organization advisors (scout leaders, club advisors, and mentors)
- Evidence you are members of The Catholic Community of Sts. James, Cornelius and Cyprian.

Applicants awarded this scholarship will need to provide documentation of full-time enrollment (12 credits or its equivalent) from an accredited institution of higher learning, including trade school, before the scholarship funds are disbursed. Funds must be used no later than for the fall semester 2026, or its equivalent.
